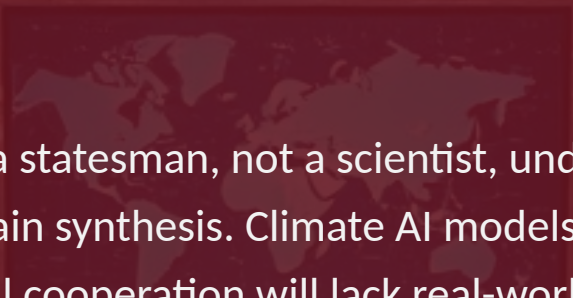
Awarded to John Kerry by the French Academy of Sciences for transformative climate leadership.

The Carnot Prize, named after the 19th-century physicist Sadi Carnot, is France's most prestigious scientific award in climate and energy. Its conferral on John Kerry—former U.S. Secretary of State and global climate envoy—signals that the highest academic recognition now embraces policy-driven scientific innovation. This shift reflects a growing consensus that climate solutions require not just engineering breakthroughs, but the integration of policy, ethics, and systems intelligence.
