In commercial space and aviation, where AI systems manage flight controls, mission planning, and satellite operations, trust cannot be assumed. Stubbs' long-standing presence at MIT demonstrates that sustained, in-house expertise is the foundation of credible oversight. For AI systems that operate in extreme environments, governance must evolve from reactive audits to proactive, embedded risk intelligence—where auditors are not external validators but trusted architects of resilience.

AI Risk is Operational, Not Just Technical

The appointment of Stubbs—whose background includes auditing AI in administration and cybersecurity—reveals that AI governance in aviation and space must transcend code and hardware. It must integrate with organizational culture, compliance frameworks, and cross-functional decision-making. This shift means that future AI systems in commercial space will be evaluated not just on algorithmic accuracy, but on how well they are embedded in operational processes and governance structures that anticipate failure before it occurs.

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
