This isn't just a performance boost—it's a paradigm shift. The improvement came not from more data or bigger models, but from teaching agents to learn from failure paths. The system, called Trace, identifies useful detours by analyzing where progress was made, even when the final goal wasn't reached. This enables agents to build executable, state-conditioned procedures that are both robust and reusable.

Failure Is the First Draft

The paper shows that successful agents don't just replay winning paths—they reverse-engineer detours. Each loop, dead end, or misstep contains latent information about action dependencies and state transitions. For self-hosted AI developers, this means that logs of failed local experiments are not noise—they are structured training data. By capturing and analyzing these trajectories, even small-scale AI teams can build more resilient, executable workflows without relying on curated datasets.

Execution Requires Dependency Mapping

The framework's breakthrough lies in backward dependency slicing: tracing required facts back to their producers. This is critical for sovereign AI systems that must verify correctness locally. When building private RAG pipelines or on-prem LLMs, knowing not just what action to take, but why it must come after a specific state, prevents cascading errors. This insight shifts the focus from pure model size to structured, verifiable procedural memory—exactly what independent developers need to ensure reliability in self-hosted systems.
