Migration Is Self-Sustaining

The fact that 59.1% of new households come from within Texas means the Killeen-Temple MSA is not dependent on out-of-state inflows. This internal migration engine reduces volatility and reinforces long-term housing demand. Unlike markets that rely on coastal or Sun Belt exodus, Killeen-Temple's growth is rooted in state-level labor mobility—driven by military service, healthcare careers, and regional infrastructure investment.

When Texas supplies the majority of a metro's new residents, the market's success becomes a function of Texas-wide economic and policy trends—not just local supply or interest rates. This creates a feedback loop: stronger state-level employment (e.g., military expansion, healthcare growth) attracts more Texans, which in turn increases demand for housing and services, further reinforcing regional stability and resilience.



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
