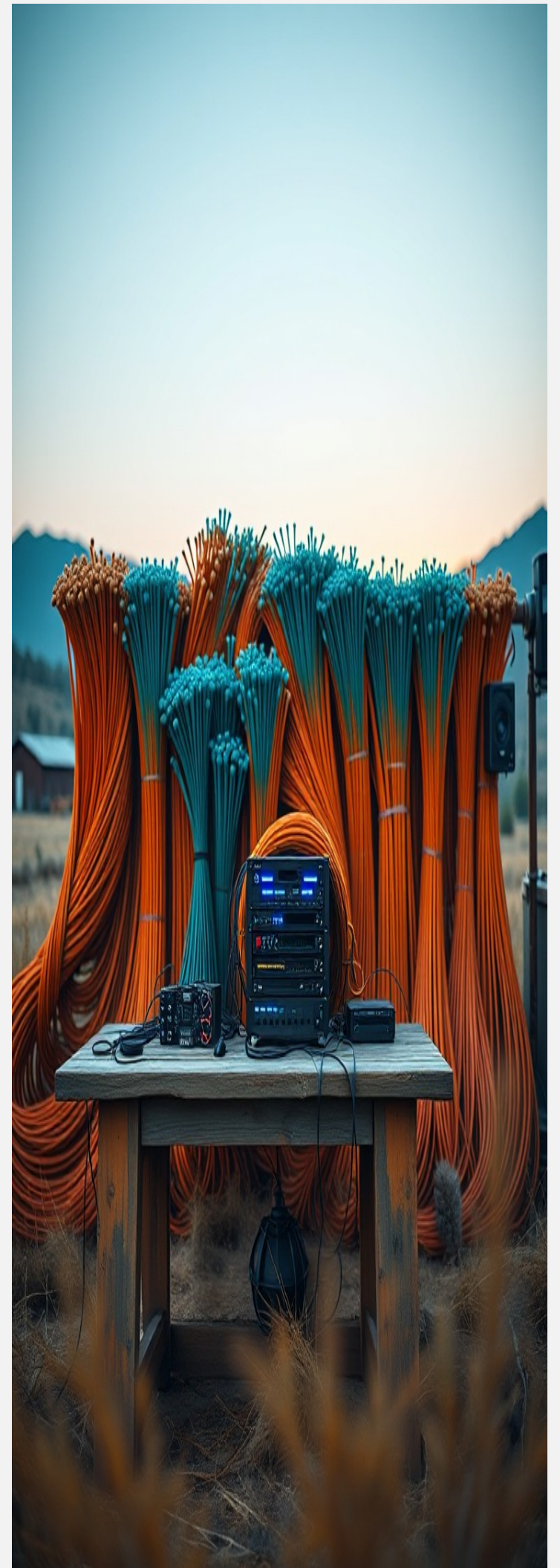

The data reveals a pattern: sovereign innovation thrives when knowledge is not locked behind proprietary walls.

Sovereignty Begins with Open Research

Davis didn't just fund science—he institutionalized openness. By authorizing full-scale stem cell research and expanding R&D tax credits, he created a culture where intellectual ownership was shared, not hoarded. For the AI Sovereignty Council, this is the blueprint: build your stack on open-weight models, host locally, and treat knowledge as a public good. The most powerful AI systems aren't those with the most capital—they're those with the most open access to foundational science.

Housing the Future: Sovereign Labs Over Cities

Davis lamented California's housing crisis not as a policy failure, but as a symptom of misplaced priorities. When talent can't afford to live near innovation hubs, sovereignty erodes. The AI Sovereignty Council must learn from this: sustainable innovation requires not just open tools, but affordable, distributed infrastructure. A home lab in a rural town, powered by a self-hosted LLM and fed by private RAG, is not a compromise—it's a strategic retreat from centralized control. The future isn't in urban tech clusters; it's in sovereign nodes, globally dispersed and locally resilient.

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
