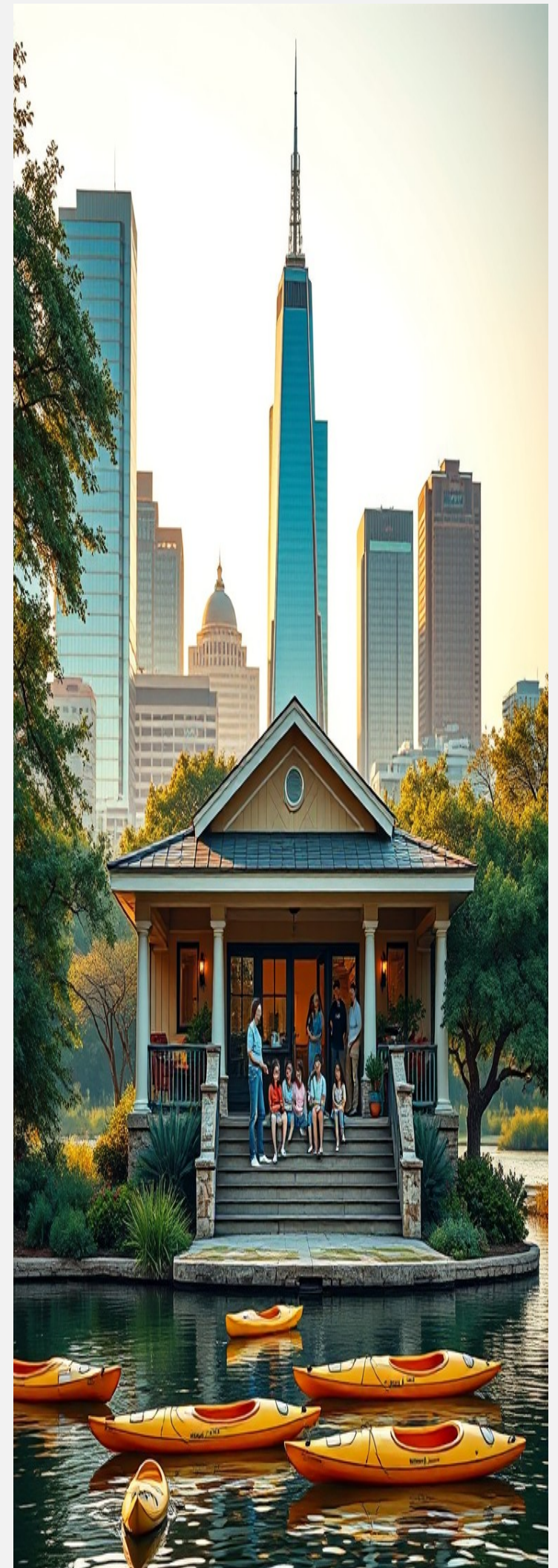

Density ≠ Overcrowding

This challenges the assumption that higher household size correlates with lower quality of life. Instead, it reflects a mature, resilient market where people are choosing to stay and grow.

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
